the Tania' held on the same day, after hearing the Union Council, after debate:

notes that the free trade union Association meeting and the meeting of the Commission 'Prospective the Tania', despite the argument of the developer to justify his rights to build participants representing various entities and activities of the Tania have condemned, unanimously, the decision of the developer (SARL LA TANIA) concerning sale of two building plots namely:

to take on the '6 G' parcel located between tennis and SABOTA 7. It is argued against the project construction in this area would call into question the path of Praz held while it appears on all documents as pedestrian access and ski Since the creation of the ZAC. This path ensures that the residents of the Saboia and l'ATREY liaison between the top and the bottom of the station and access to the trails in compensation for the non-realization of an elevator and a gateway in the plan of ZAC (duty to equipment),

the other to take on non-informed parcel located on the edge of the runway of the Polyères. It is argued against the project that a construction in this area would be likely to question the existence of a curtain of trees and the part in the forest. It could also impact the runway and defeat not made a binding project tracks between the cottage and the centre of the station.

In the light of the information provided, the General Assembly endorsed the position taken by various representatives in the meetings of the 3.01.2012, and decided to involve the Union of the co-owners 'The Kalinka' at all steps, amicable or contentious, coordinated by the free Association of the Tania to prevent the development of the sought-after plots once it is clear that the (or the) permit to build is (or will be) given (s) contrary to the rules of urban planning, and gives delegation to representatives of the building to monitor the case and make a decision that would be necessary. The decision of the building 'Kalinka' in point 6 of the minutes of the general meeting of 27/02/1 999 is therefore not challenged and can be used to assert that right. 24) Issues relevant to the overall functioning of co-ownership

Collection of indexes of consumption, balance accounts of co-ownership, distribution équitable expenditures of water: it is recalled that, under the provisions of the regulation of co-ownership of the building, an owner must leave his apartment key to the Syndic's Office or a person resident on the spot (which coordinates must be brought to the attention of GSI) to facilitate any justified intervention (ex.) (: water damage, noted annual meters).

The trustee says that lacked February 16, 2012, the indexes of the counters of the apartments of the owners: SWEENS (101), DICKENS (105), TAYLOR (106), MAC BEATH (204), BROWN (205), BADIA (206), DELORAINE (207), BROSSARD (307), AUSSUD (308), RIOLET (404), GOLFIER (405/406).

Provided that it is not in the powers of the trustee and companies to recover the keys to the apartments at different points of the station.

Maintenance of meters of water and stop valves: each owner must periodically check the functioning of its water meters and ensure maintenance of stop valves. This precaution will avoid the risk of water damage. Repeated or prolonged absence, these valves shall be systematically closed.

The trustee informs that the counter EDF of the building was replaced in April 2011 after a failure that EDF has found. Called powers and the consumption of heating and collective facilities (domestic hot water, Elevator, the common lighting) is not recorded properly, being specified that the failure was until then for the benefit of the co-ownership. However, he was asked the company Knight to perform an analysis of consumption of facilities and a measure of the powers actually needed to operate these facilities and as a result, adjust the contract tariff yellow. The results of the study and verification of the new electronic counter confirmed billed consumption level. Also, expenses of electricity for heating, hot water, the elevator and the common lighting shall be adjusted proportionately to the billing.

Reminder to homeowners performing renovation in custodial parties: co-ownership regrets to note that some

owners and their companies mandated by them is are not respectful of common areas at the time of the work. It is not acceptable that fixtures, appliances, furniture etc... be left in common areas (corridors, local garbage) while the building rules and regulations relating to the selective sorting prohibit it. These practices should be prohibited for the good conduct and the general appearance of the building.

Selective sorting of garbage: the garbage cans of the co-owned local is used to exclusively collect garbage. It is strictly prohibited to place of bulky to evacuate directly in the dump.

Any occupant must apply the sorting based on voluntary intake recommendations. To this end, various collection points were built near the building. Thank you comply.

Balcony handrail: apart from reducing campaigns, each co-owner must maintain once a year his hand common balcony and this, through a manual sanding of support by a paper of glass and then to the application of a glazing paint. The reference of the glazing paint is: the LORD .TEXWOOD REF 7831.

Some owners have taken the initiative to install their own antenna visible television since the facade. However, condominium regulations stipulates that building with collective antenna TV 9.11.2005, individual external antenna installation is not allowed (2nd part, title I, section D, page 28 of regulation of co-ownership).

To preserve the General harmony of the building and maintain the heritage value of the apartments, the concerned owners are asked to rule the co-ownership and withdraw their private installation.

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25) Respect for the rules of Immeuble and respect of the essential rules of life condominium

For the good conduct and general maintenance of the building, each owner must ensure compliance with the rules laid down, namely:

Do not park his vehicle at the entrance of the building,

Do not place of bulky in the local garbage and comply scrupulously with the sorting instructions,

Do not leave wandering pets and pick up their droppings,

Respect common areas clean and quiet of all,

Do not discard cigarette butts over the balconies or other detritus (bottles, paper etcà)

Do not borrow the corridors in ski shoes,

Do not store personal belongings before the apartments or on the edges of the Windows (example: shoes, strollers, linen, sleds, etc)

Immediately evacuate household waste that will need to be packed in waterproof to file in the communal bins outside shelter, plastic pockets

Equipping felt the legs of chairs and other furniture to be moved on a daily basis.

Do not install individual antenna TV in front of the building,
